1. Name the Sacraments of Initiation.
2. How is Baptism administered?

4. What is Confirmation?
5. What is required of a candidate for Confirmation?
6. What happens in Confirmation?
7. How are you changed when you receive the Eucharist?
8. What event takes place in 1 Corinthians 11:23-25?



**Due February 12, 2017 Why do I have to go to Mass?**

1. What is Holy Eucharist?
2. Why is the Eucharist important for the Church?
3. What happens in the Church when she celebrates the Eucharist?
